## LEVEL 1- LEVEL 4

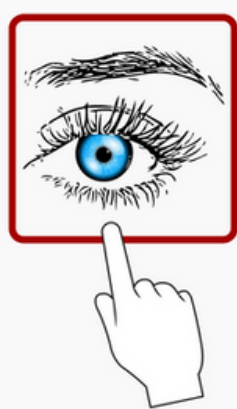


STUDENTS MUST BE REGISTERED FOR THE NATIONAL PORTUGUESE EXAM IN THE LEVEL WHICH CORRESPONDS TO THE SAME PORTUGUESE COURSE IN WHICH THEY ARE CURRENTLY ENROLLED.



THIS ALLOWS STUDENTS WITH LIKE-EXPOSURE TO COMPETE WITH EACH OTHER.

# NPE LEVEL 1-LEVEL 4

## LEVEL 1

For students where the course content is equivalent to the second-half of 1st-year high school Portuguese (i.e. Grade 8) or entry-level for any program where the course content is equivalent to a *full* year of high school Portuguese.

## LEVEL 2

Second level of high school Portuguese.

## LEVEL 3

Third level of high school Portuguese.

## LEVEL 4

Fourth level of high school Portuguese.
