Chapter Fee

In addition to the mandatory \$4.00 national fee per student, teachers *may* choose to participate in the local chapter contest by paying the additional chapter fee per student which entitles the student to the following:

### Chapter Prize Structure

Paying the above chapter fee entitles each qualifying student to receive the following chapter prizes:

#### **MEDALS** to National Award Winners

- Gold medals for students scoring at or above the 95<sup>th</sup> percentile
- Silver medals for students scoring from the 85<sup>th</sup> through 94<sup>th</sup> percentiles
- Bronze medals for students scoring from the 75<sup>th</sup> through 84<sup>th</sup> percentiles

#### **FLAG PIN**

- Awarded to students scoring from the 50<sup>th</sup> through the 74<sup>th</sup> percentiles.

#### **BANQUET** for the top student at each level

**MONETARY AWARD, PLAQUE, and GOLD MEDAL** awarded to the top scorer at each level and category

- \$50-\$500

**Notes:** The cash awards vary each year depending on the number of chapter participants and chapter winners.

The top scorer for each level and category, his/her teacher and parents are invited to a ceremony and dinner at Regis College. They have the opportunity to meet the Education Director, The Consul General of Spain and the representative from Aula Cervantes.

Students in the Outside Experience or Bilingual category must have a score equal to or greater than the Classroom Experience category student to which his/her score is being compared. If his/her score is lower, then they are not eligible for special chapter cash awards and prizes but they will receive a medal according to the percentile.

The top score is decided by the highest score in each percentile category. On occasion there is a tie and both students are awarded the special prizes although the prize money may be split depending on the money collected during registration.
