Award Category


Shows the **award** that the student is eligible for. If it is blank, the student is not eligible for an award.

Measurement Category Scores

Categories

Premio de Oro

Students scoring at or above the 95th percentile.



Premio de Plata

Students scoring from the 85th - 94th percentile.



Premio de Bronce

Students scoring from the 75th - 84th percentile.



Mención Honorífica

Students scoring from the 50th - 74th percentile.
