The **National Spanish Examinations** (NSE) office is a branch of the American Association of Teachers of Spanish and Portuguese (AATSP).

Our mission is to recognize student achievement and to promote language proficiency in the studies of Spanish & Portuguese. To this end, the National Spanish Examinations office is committed to providing Teachers with assessment tools and offering Students opportunities to know their language skill ratings in vocabulary, grammar, reading comprehension, and listening comprehension.



The **National Spanish Exam** (NSE) is a motivational competition to recognize student achievement and proficiency in the study of Spanish. In addition to the competition, this exam is an online, standardized assessment tool for Grades 6-12 that measures content standards (vocabulary and grammar) and performance standards (reading and listening comprehension).


At the National level, students are able to receive <u>medal placement</u> (gold, silver, bronze, honorable mention) based on their percentile scores and are eligible to apply for several types of <u>scholarships</u> (Global Citizen Scholarship, Junior Study Abroad Program, Senior Scholarship).

Each level has two sections of tests: (1) Achievement is 40 minutes total and includes two subsections: Vocabulary and Grammar. (2) Proficiency is 40 minutes total and includes two subsections of reading and listening.


