## WHO WE ARE

The National Spanish Examinations (NSE) is a program of the American Association of Teachers of Spanish and Portuguese (AATSP) that is committed to recognizing student achievement and promoting language proficiency in the studies of Spanish and Portuguese.

## WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Apply if you are a graduating senior who is college-bound in the Fall of 2024 *and...*

- You scored at or above the 75th percentile on the NSE/NPE in 2022 or 2023 **AND** are taking the 2024 NSE/NPE
- **OR** You placed Gold in the 2024 National Spanish Exam (NSE) or the National Portuguese Exam (NPE).



### SCHOLARSHIP

The Senior Scholarship will award \$1,000 to eligible graduating seniors to support their post-secondary educational expenses.



### DEADLINE

Application deadline is on May 3rd, 2024.



### ANNOUNCEMENT

Award recipients will be announced in August 2024.

# APPLICATION CHECKLIST

2024 SENIOR SCHOLARSHIPS



**DEADLINE:**  
**May 3rd, 2024**

## REQUIREMENTS:

- I am taking the 2023-24 National Spanish Exam/National Portuguese Exam.
- I scored at or above the 75th percentile (Bronze or Silver) in 2022 or 2023 on the NSE/NPE.  
**OR** I scored (or plan to score) at or above the 95th percentile (Gold) in the 2024 NSE/NPE.
- I am graduating high school at the end of the 2023-24 school year and college-bound in 2024.

## HOW TO APPLY:

- High School Transcript**  
Submit evidence of 7 semesters of grades **OR** a signed statement from a sponsoring teacher and one parent/guardian stating that the applicant is completing their final/senior year in high school and will be moving on at the end of the 2023-24 year.
- Persuasive Essay**  
Submit a persuasive essay *in Spanish* of no more than one typewritten page in which you discuss one of the pre-selected topics as presented in the [official guidelines](#).
- Letter of Recommendation**  
One letter of recommendation from a teacher (or a principal, guidance counselor, tutor, etc.).
- Video Interview**  
Submit a link to a standard video clip *in Spanish* posted on YouTube that adheres to the official guidelines.
- Online Application**  
Submit all of the application materials to the appropriate Google Form.
